<sup>4</sup>For some operating foundations, total giving amount includes grants and program expenses; for others, total giving amount includes only grants. Most operating foundations' qualifying distributions are paid out for administration of operating programs and not for grants.

<sup>5</sup>In 2007, the Peninsula Community Foundation and the Community Foundation Silicon Valley merged to become the Silicon Valley Community Foundation.
