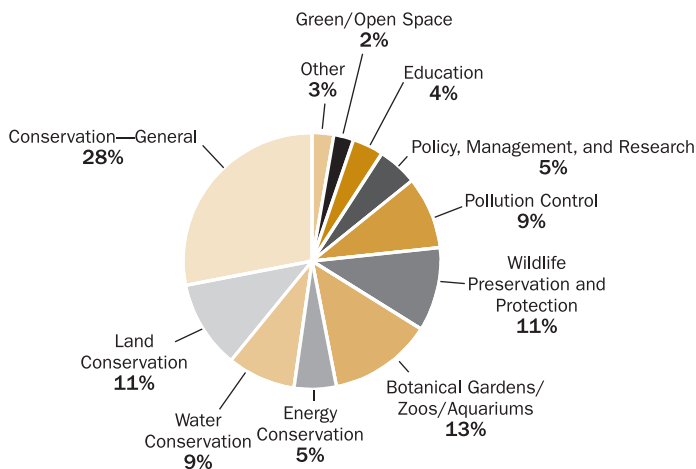
Larger U.S. Foundation Giving for the Environment and Animals, All Recipients vs. Georgia, 2001 and 2006

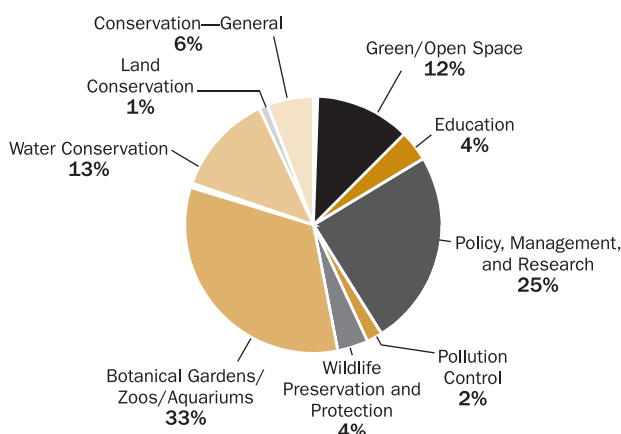

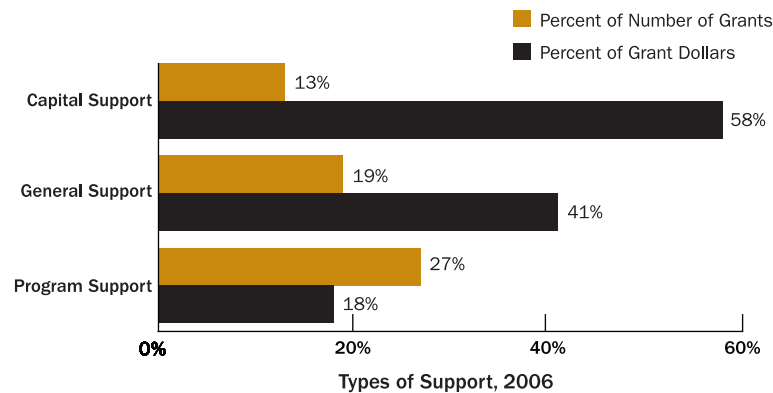

The Foundation Center indexes all of the grants of \$10,000 and more awarded by more than 1,200 of the nation's largest private and community foundations. This report is based on the Center's most recent (2006) sample, which includes 140,484 grants awarded by 1,263 U.S. foundations totaling \$19.1 billion. The report analyzes environment and animal grants made to Georgia recipients by 46 foundations, 15 that are based in Georgia and 31 that are based outside Georgia, totaling \$32.2 million.
